KALAM is a multidisciplinary, refereed biannual international research journal published by the Faculty of Arts and Culture of the South Eastern University of Sri Lanka. It aims to encourage multifaceted, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary research on Humanities and Social Sciences. Volume 13, Nos. 1 & 2 will be published in November 2020, respectively. Both issues will accept original research articles and book reviews for publication if submitted in the following manner.

GUIDELINES

Article Types for Submission: All full-text articles and book reviews should be original and previously unpublished research results. Findings of both experimental and theoretical studies would be considered for publication. Manuscripts are accepted on the understanding that they have not been published elsewhere and are not currently under consideration by another journal. The submitting author is responsible for ensuring that all the other co-authors have approved the publication of the article.

It is also the authors' responsibility to ensure that articles originating from a particular institution are submitted with the approval of that institution. The correspondence and proofs will be sent to the author(s) before publication. It is a condition of acceptance of a paper that the author(s) allow editing of the article for improved readability. All enquiries concerning the publication of accepted manuscripts should be addressed to the Editor-in-Chief of Kalam.

Peer Review Process: All manuscripts are subjected to a peer-review process to determine if they meet the criteria for scientific significance and academic excellence. An Editor-in-Chief will first scrutinize a submission, and if he approves of same, it will be moved on to be judged by peer-reviewers, whose identities will not be disclosed to the author(s).

If the paper can be accepted subject to certain changes, then the author(s) will be requested to incorporate the changes suggested by the reviewers. The Editor-in-Chief will then review the revised manuscript after the changes have been made by the author(s). Once he is satisfied with the amended manuscript, the accepted article will be published on a final decision made by the Editor-in-Chief.

Title and Authorship Information: The following information should be included.

- 1. Title of paper
- 2. Full name of the author(s)
- 3. Name of institute and name of the department
- 4. Country name
- 5. E-mail addresses of the author(s)

Abstract: A concise summary outlining in a single paragraph (amounting to not more than 200 words – line space: single) the aim, scope and conclusion of the paper must be provided.

Keywords: Immediately following the abstract, a maximum of five keywords must be given in alphabetical order (avoid words like 'and' & 'of'). Use abbreviations sparingly - only abbreviations firmly established in the field are permitted.

Structure of Main Text: Manuscripts must be set out in the following order – Title, Authors, Affiliations, Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, the Main text under sub-headings, Conclusions, Acknowledgements, Appendix, References, Figure Captions, Figures, and then Tables.

Copyright: All authors must sign the Transfer of Copyright Agreement before the article can be published. This Transfer Agreement enables the publishers to protect the copyrighted material on behalf of the authors but does not void the authors' proprietary rights. The copyright transfer covers

the exclusive rights to reproduce and distribute the article, including reprints, photographic reproductions, microfilm or any other reproductions of similar nature and any translations. The proofreading is solely the author's responsibility. Any queries should be answered in full. Authors must correct factual errors and any errors introduced during typesetting.

The guidelines and other important dates:

- 1. The date for calling the full papers: From 24th of August to 23rd of September, 2020 for both issues.
- 2. Revised paper should be sent on or before the 10th of October, 2020 for both issues.
- 3. For English text: Garamond size 11
- 4. For Tamil text: Akarathi font size 11
- 5. Line space: 1.15
- 6. Word limit: An article should be around 3000 to 5000 words and not exceed 6000 words, including references and endnotes.
- 7. The full research article should consist of the following significant elements:
 - a. Introduction / background
 - b. Problem statement
 - c. Objective(s)
 - d. Methodology
 - e. Literature survey
 - f. Results and discussion
 - g. Conclusion and references (APA method).
